HPGM collaborates with and supports more than 100 community organizations, employers, Employee Resource Groups/Business Resource Groups, higher education partners, membership organizations, non-profits, and small businesses. We support ERGs and employers in identifying talent and serve as the connector for aspiring and current Latino professionals.



#### **Employer Partners**

HPGM supports corporate and employer partners in the region by identifying Latino talent for recruitment, development, and advancement opportunities across various industries and sectors. Collaboration with employers and Business Resource Groups increases belonging, and fosters a welcoming workplace that increases retention and advancement of employees, builds a future-focused workforce to meet customer needs and achieve business imperatives.

Small businesses and entrepreneurs are provided with a network of professionals and various communication platforms to share information about their businesses. HPGM provides professional development and community connections to help entrepreneurs grow as leaders, as well as scale their business operations.



## **OUR LEADERSHIP**

As we look back on 2024, we're filled with gratitude for the unwavering support of our members, donors, partners, sponsors, and the entire comunidad. It was a year full of growth, connection, and transformation. With your continued support, we moved closer to our vision: a Wisconsin where every Latino has the opportunity to thrive, and reach their highest potential for themselves, their familias, and their comunidades.

This past year, we saw incredible progress in many areas. We launched Alianza Latina de ERGs (ALE), a collective that unites employee resource group leaders to foster belonging among Latino/Hispanic employees while enriching workplace cultures. We proudly awarded 15 scholarships to students from seven different institutions in Wisconsin. We also celebrated a significant achievement - raising \$500,000 at our Annual Gala Experience for the second year in a row. These accomplishments are a direct reflection of the generosity and commitment of our comunidad, and a testament to those who believe in our mission.

We also experienced strong growth and formed meaningful partnerships throughout the year. HPGM's membership grew from 3,600 to 5,200 strong, demonstrating the unity and resilience of our comunidad. We proudly partnered with the Southside Organizing Center, committing to a \$20/hour minimum wage for all our employees as part of our ongoing advocacy for pay equity and economic prosperity. In addition, we were honored to be selected as one of four organizations for the inaugural Bader Leadership Institute, where we'll collaborate with emerging leaders passionate about supporting Wisconsin's non-profits.

As we look toward our 25th anniversary, we're more energized than ever to continue our work and expand our impact. We refreshed our Mission, Vision, and Values with input from over 50 stakeholders, launched phase 2 of our rebrand with Odvant Creative, and gathered invaluable feedback through our member survey. None of this progress would have been possible without your continued dedication and support.

The trust you have placed in HPGM continues to ignite our passion to create a Wisconsin where Latinos, their familias, and the broader community can thrive. Thank you for believing in our leadership and for being an essential part of HPGM's comunidad!



- In direct response to member feedback requesting more wellness opportunities, HPGM added a new wellness-focused partnership with Buena Tierra Run Club to promoting physical wellness and community engagement.
- Sponsored a dedicated team for the Black & Brown Run Around
   5K event, fostering member participation and visibility.
- Buena Tierra's weekly run clubs regularly attract 160 participants, creating ongoing spaces for health, connection, and representation.






### **Gala Experience**

### **Board Pipeline Initiative**

Board Pipeline Initiative is a virtual training program that introduces professionals to the foundational concepts of board service. Session topics include board basics, financials, exploring various types of boards/committees, fundraising, partnerships and more.

Our goal is to increase representation for Latinos on non-profit committees and boards, with the broader goal of increasing representation for Latinos on both volunteer and paid corporate boards.

### Advancing Students

HPGM removes financial barriers to education, increases the educational attainment of Latino students, closes achievement gaps, and prepares Latino students for the workforce. HPGM's eco-system of employer partners, higher education partners, and active student chapters ensures that rising leaders have pathways to careers in the region and financial support to complete their degrees.

HPGM partners with the Wisconsin Hispanic Lawyers Association (WHLA) to provide scholarships for Latino students attending University of Wisconsin Law School and Marquette University Law School. One student from each law school will be awarded the HPGM Law School Scholarship.

Since 2004, HPGM's Scholarship Program has awarded over

\$915,000 to 256 Latino students throughout Wisconsin.












#### Scholar Spotlight
